On the 2nd of December 2021 years 4-6 went down to Nockolds Street to sell our unique and improved products.

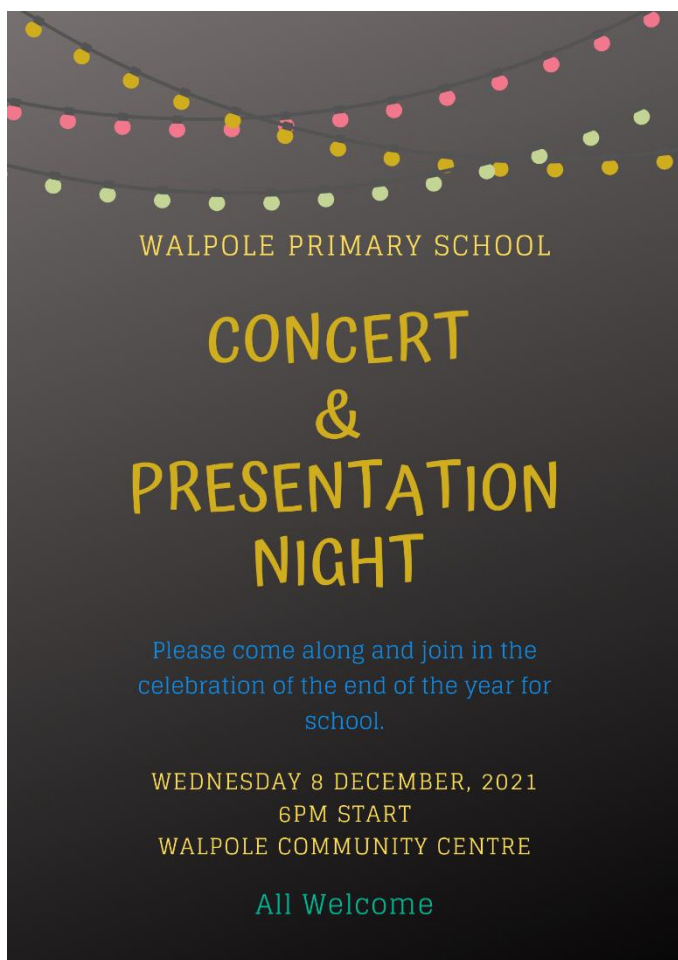
